Studio Curriculum Overview and Schemes of Work 2024-25

Pupils attending Studio Music lessons have had a wide range of different encounters with the Music curriculum. Some may have learned music or musical instruments for a term at a time on a rotation with other subjects. Some will have had little or inconsistent provision of music education. The S30 curriculum introduces and consolidates key musical skills; vocal skills, keyboard skills, use of a digital audio workspace (DAW); and concepts; listening and appraising music using key terms; and basic concepts of music theory. The delivery of these concepts is adapted to tailor to the specific needs of our S30 students, on an individual basis.
